## This term's healthy recipe idea:-

### Tangy chicken cous cous

#### Ingredients

275g cous cous	6 tbsp Worcestershire sauce	1 courgette finely diced
1 red pepper, cored & finely diced	4 spring onions, finely chopped	125g dried apricots, finely diced
2 tomatoes, finely chopped	4 chicken breasts, cooked & cut into strips	

#### Method

1. Place the cous cous in a large bowl and pour over the Worcestershire sauce.
2. Add 300ml (1/2 pint) of boiling water, mix well then add the remaining ingredients, except the chicken.
3. Cover the mixture and leave in a cool place for at least 15 minutes.
4. Stir in the cooked chicken and serve.
