
GRAPES

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING COLLECTION OF YOUR CHILD

If a child is not being collected by any of their named contacts - we will require advance notice of who is to be collecting them and that person **MUST** have the password and **MUST** be 16 years or over.

Just having the password will **NOT** be sufficient to allow someone to collect your child — **YOU MUST INFORM US IN ADVANCE.**

Could you please also ensure that you collect your child on time— if you are late collecting we may have to ask staff to stay on which will result in you incurring a £10 charge.

Please remember that you are responsible for signing your child in and out on the register. This helps to ensure that all children are safe within the setting.

Pre-existing injuries

Can parents please remember that if your child comes into nursery with any injuries or marks, you will need to let a member of staff know when you drop them off. We will then give you a pre-existing injury form to fill out.

Dogs

Hedgehogs (3-5's)

This term we will be looking at healthy eating and talking about Harvest time. We will be doing a range of activities to promote healthy living, such as creating food plates, cooking and looking at where different foods come from. We also have our own healthy eating cafe where the children will be able to act out their experiences and serve food to their friends.



Owls (2 year olds)



As we come into Autumn we will be looking at how the trees and plants change colour. We will be finding out which fruits we can harvest and taste, doing leaf prints, painting with foods and exploring textures.

We will need to find our coats, hats and scarves ready for the colder, windy weather and talk about how to protect ourselves against the weather.

Caterpillars (Babies)



This term our topic & theme will be based on harvest. We will be looking at foods that are in season such as apples, pears, avocados, broccoli, blackberries & parsnips. We will also be looking at autumn, the colours, leaves and the clothes we wear. Our activities will consist of food tasting, autumn colour painting, messy play such as gloop & play dough and using our dressing up clothes to encourage independence & understanding of how to put our clothes on.
