This term this Owls will be celebrating the Chinese New Year. We will be exploring different tastes & having fun making little dragons and colourful stain glass windows.

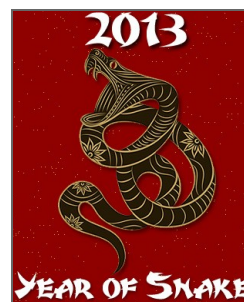


## Hedgehogs
